There are 2 awkward situations you have to watch out for with the genitive.

① Where you have to make a noun genitive that has an adjective coming after it. In this case, you have to make the adjective genitive too.

ex. Seán Óg's house = Teach Sheáin Óig.

Dónall Mór's car = Carr Dónaill Mhóir.

② Where there are 2 genitives in a row. In this case, have to put just a *h* on the first genitive, and handle the second as normal.

ex. Manager of the chemist's shop =
Bainisteoir shiopa an phoitigéara.

In the middle of the bedroom =
I láir an sheomra leapa.

Nóta: In a double genitive like this, you will never have 2 *an*'s. You have to drop the first *an* to make way for the second.

ex. an seomra

+ an mínteoir eolaíochta

= an seomra an mínteoir eolaíochta X

= seomra an mhínteoir eolaíochta ✓
